<p>Jesus Calms the Storm Mark 4:35-41</p>	<p>After teaching in parables, Jesus tells his disciples they are going to the other side. After he falls asleep a fierce storm comes up, but Jesus is sleeping. The disciples wake him up and He rebukes the waves and the wind and everything calms down. Then he rebukes his disciples for their lack of faith.</p>	<p>"I have control over nature. Don't be afraid."</p>
<p>Healing the Demoniac Mark 5:1-20</p>	<p>An uncontrolled demoniac is filled with a "legion" of demons that screams Jesus' identity. Jesus casts the demons into a herd of 2,000 pigs. HE sends the man home well.</p>	<p>"I have power over Satan and demons,. Don't be afraid."</p>
<p>Woman of Faith Mark 5:24-34</p>	<p>As Jesus is going to Jairus' house, a woman touches his garment secretly to be healed of her bleeding. Jesus know s power has gone out of him and waits until the woman comes forward.</p>	<p>"I have control over sickness. Don't be afraid."</p>
<p>Jairus' Daughter Mark 5:21-24, 35-43</p>	<p>A ruler of the synagogue, Jairus, asks Jesus to heal his daughter. The girl dies as Jesus is on the way. Jesus privately resurrects her.</p>	<p>"I have control over death. Don't be afraid."</p>
