






<p data-bbox="112 411 208 451">Matt.</p> <h3 data-bbox="222 354 548 396">Mustard Seed</h3> 	<p data-bbox="709 365 1219 468">Tiniest seed. Buried and planted.</p> <p data-bbox="709 491 1141 646">Full-grown=biggest. Birds are in the branches.</p>	
<p data-bbox="112 743 208 783">Matt.</p> <h3 data-bbox="197 686 608 729">The Yeast Dough</h3> 	<p data-bbox="709 701 1141 972">Woman puts yeast in dough. It's unseen and hidden. The dough gets big and expands.</p>	
<p data-bbox="112 1076 208 1116">Matt.</p> <h3 data-bbox="137 1033 649 1076">The Wheat and Tares</h3> 	<p data-bbox="709 1019 1251 1290">Farmer sows wheat. Enemy sows tares. Crops grow together; workers want to weed. "Wait"—tares destroyed at end.</p>

<p data-bbox="208 1051 517 1093"><b>The Dragnet</b></p> <p data-bbox="131 1112 193 1148">Ma</p> 	<p data-bbox="710 1051 1244 1322">A fisherman gets all sorts of fish: good and rotten. He sorts them on the shore and throws the bad away.</p>

Title:	Details:	Meaning
<b>Mustard Seed</b> Matt. 13:31-32	Tiniest seed. Buried and planted. Full-grown=biggest. Birds are in the branches.	Hidden Small...grows. Doesn't look big but becomes evident later.
<b>The Yeast Dough</b> Matt. 13:33-35	Woman puts yeast in dough. It's unseen and hidden. The dough gets big and expands.	Hidden Small...grows. Can't see it right away but later can see effects.
<b>The Wheat and Tares</b> Matt. 13:36-43	Farmer sows wheat. Enemy sows tares. Crops grow together; workers want to weed. "Wait"—tares destroyed at end.	Hidden...grows. Wheat=good people Tares=bad people. Becomes evident at the end
<b>The Hidden Treasure</b> Matt. 13:44	A man finds a buried treasure. He sells everything and buys the field.	Hidden Valuable Costly to get it
<b>The White Pearl</b> Matt. 13:45-46	A merchant finds a valuable pearl. He sells everything and buys the pearl.	Valuable Small Costly to get it
<b>The Dragnet</b> Matt. 13:47-52	A fisherman gets all sorts of fish: good and rotten. He sorts them on the shore and throws the bad away.	Mix of good and bad. Wicked are separated from the righteous and destroyed at the Judgment.
